We plan for you to meet leaders from the Uganda National Oil Company, Petroleum Authority of Uganda, the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Development, LAPSSET, which is running a \$24.5bn investment project in Kenya, Tanzania Petroleum Development Corporation, Nilepet, Uganda Investment Authority, Stanbic Bank, Simba Group, and the Association of Uganda Oil & Gas suppliers. You will also be able to meet and discuss informally with oil and gas students from the Virtual University of Uganda, who may become your employees.

Uganda's oil & gas industry has seen investment of \$3bn between 2006 and 2016, and is projected to need \$20bn worth of investment in the sector as it edges towards Final Investment Decision for its Tilenga and Kingfisher projects. This will make Uganda a major oil & gas producer in East and Central Africa. Kenya and Tanzania have also made significant hydrocarbon discoveries and are currently developing them.
